The Epilepsy Foundation is a registered NDIS provider and is currently delivering services for people with epilepsy in areas where the NDIS has already rolled out. If you are already receiving support through the Epilepsy Foundation it's a good idea to ensure these are included in your NDIS Plan.

Alternatively, if you are in the beginning stages and planning for the NDIS, consider including Epilepsy Foundation services and support as part of your NDIS Plan. Depending on your circumstances we may not be able to provide services to you for free, but if it's included in your NDIS Plan this will cover the cost of supports and services provided by us.
